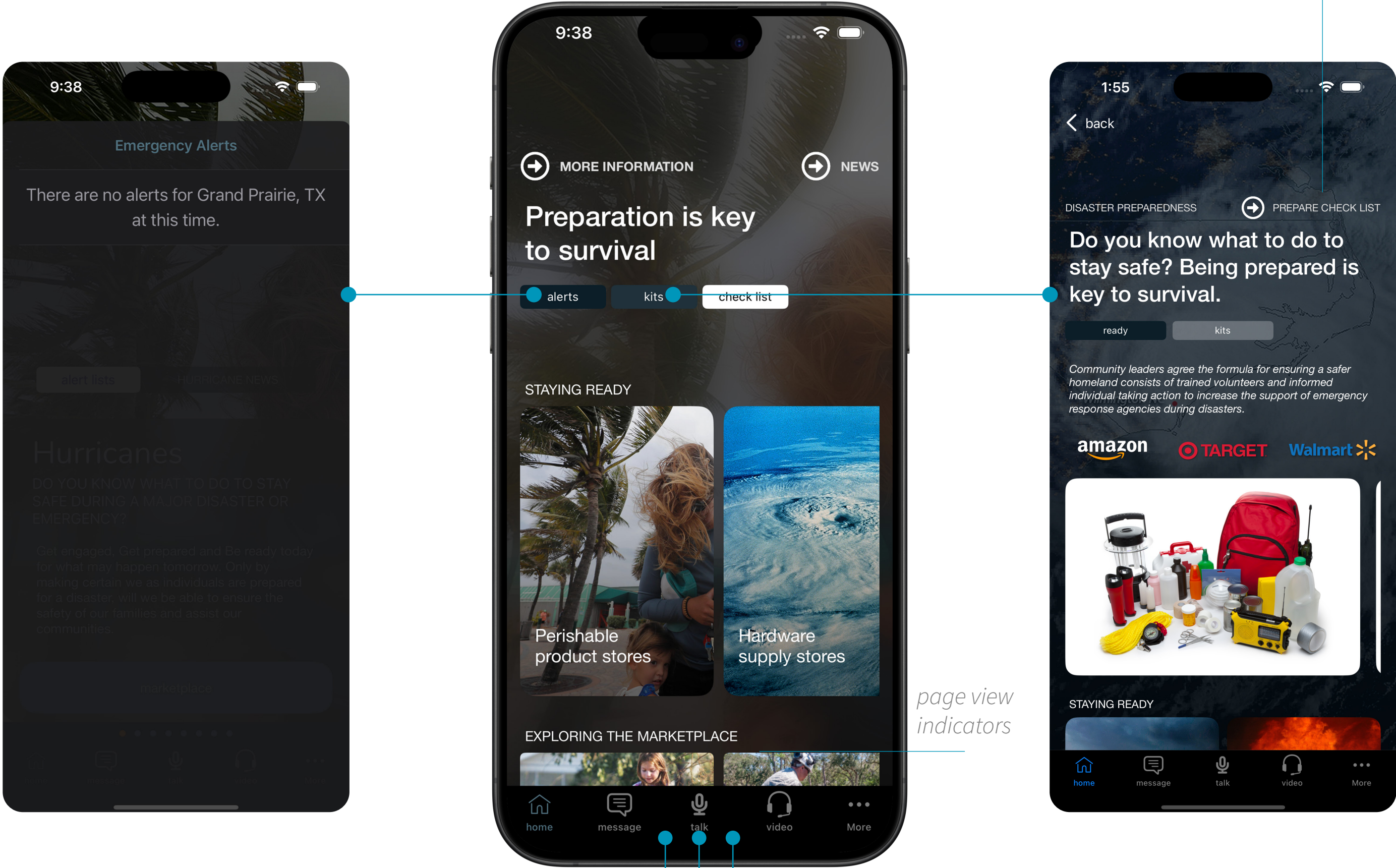

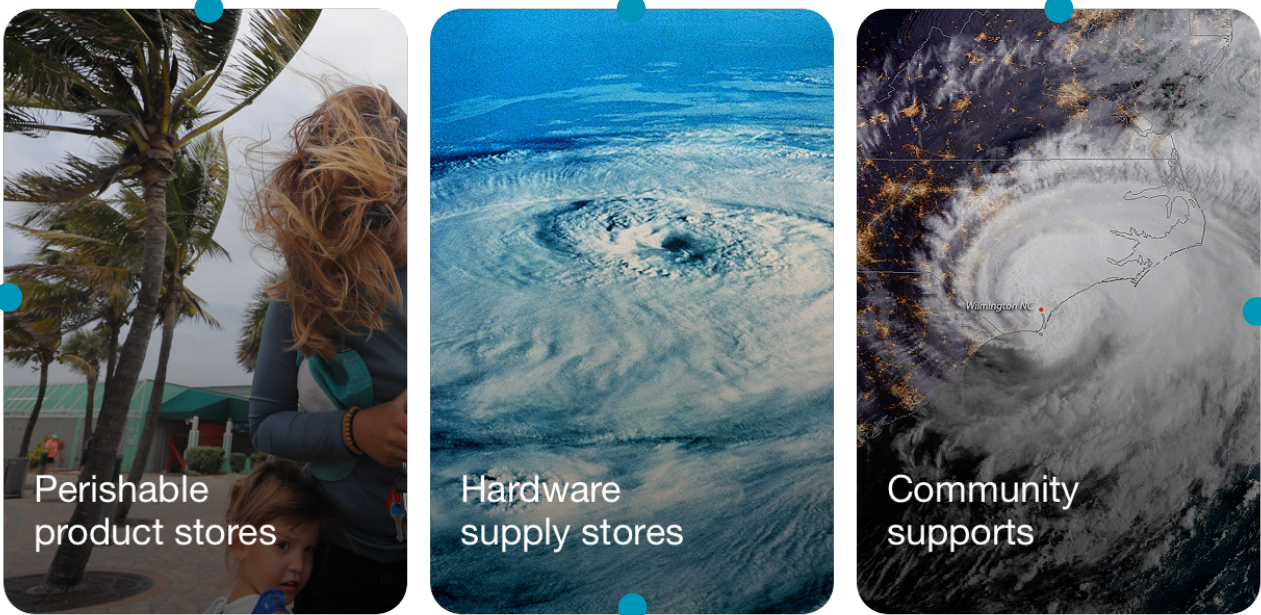
Survival kit page

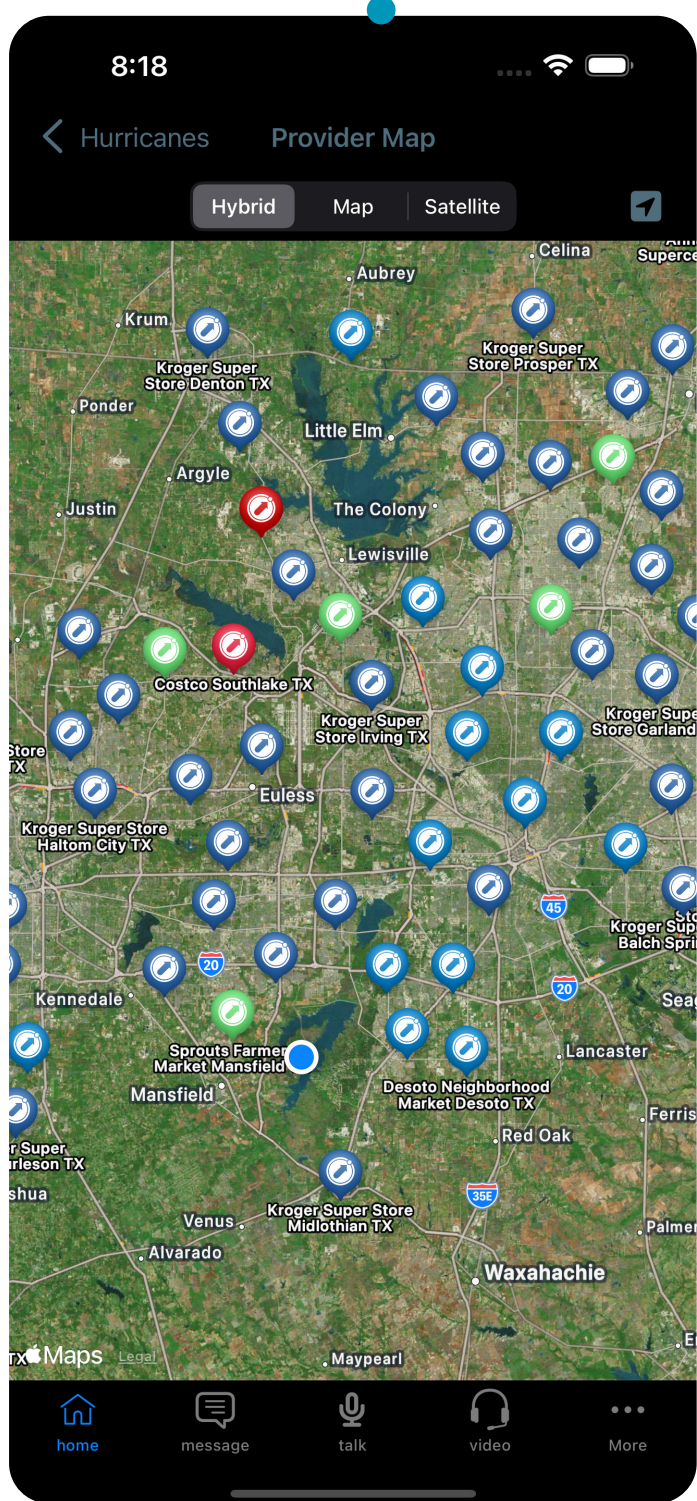
Be prepared for disasters and other emergencies with a well-stocked emergency kit for your home, workplace and automobile. After an emergency, you may need to survive on your own for several days.



Essential emergency supplies

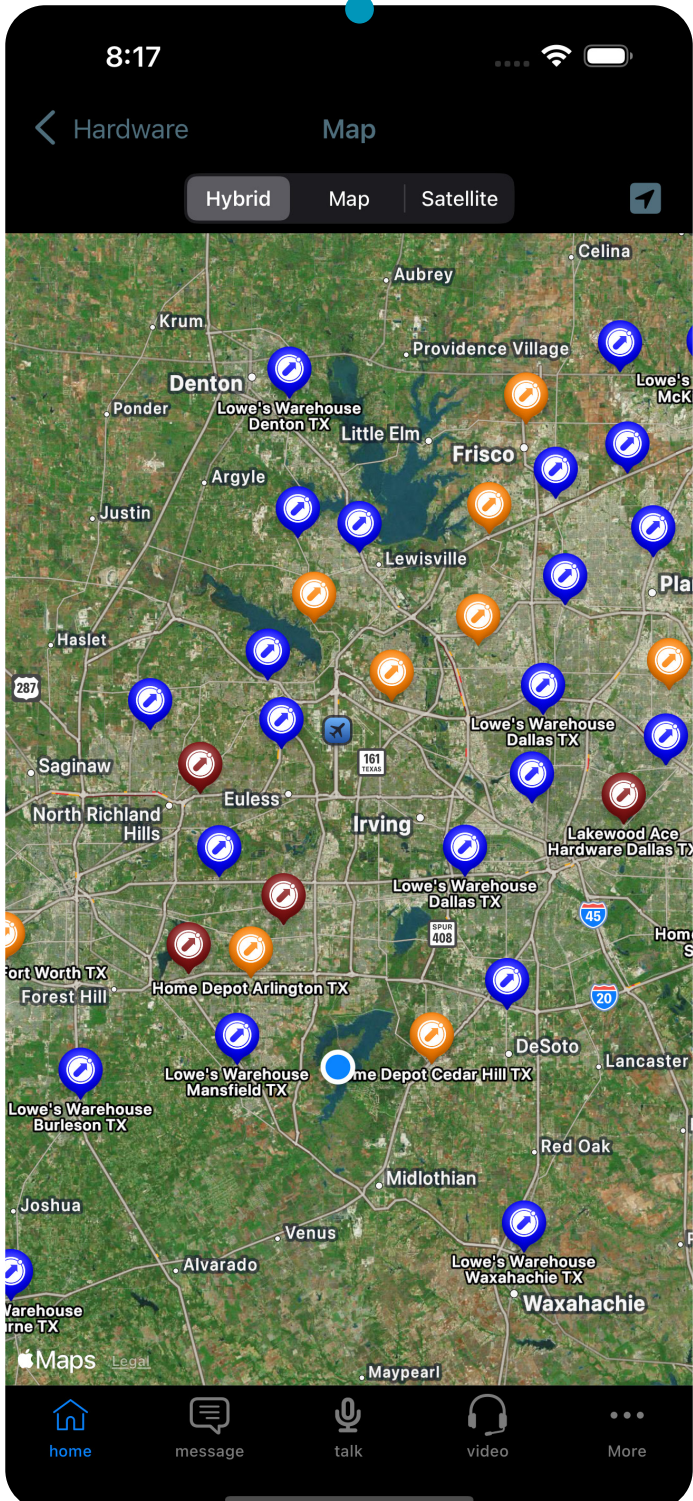
At a minimum your emergency supply kit should include these 10 essential items.

1. **WATER FOR 3-10 DAYS**
(1 gallon per person per day)
2. **FOOD FOR 3-10 DAYS**
(including pet food)
3. **MEDICATIONS**
(prescription and non-prescription)
4. **RADIO**
(& extra batteries)
5. **FLASHLIGHTS**
(and extra batteries)
6. **FIRST AID KIT**
(bandages, disinfecting wipes, gauzes, medical tape)
7. **CASH AND IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS**
(small bills, coins, birth certificates, medical cards, licenses, USB)
8. **SANITATION AND HYGIENE SUPPLIES**
9. **TOOLS**
(wrench, duct tape, fire extinguisher, sturdy gloves)
10. **CLOTHING AND STURDY SHOES**



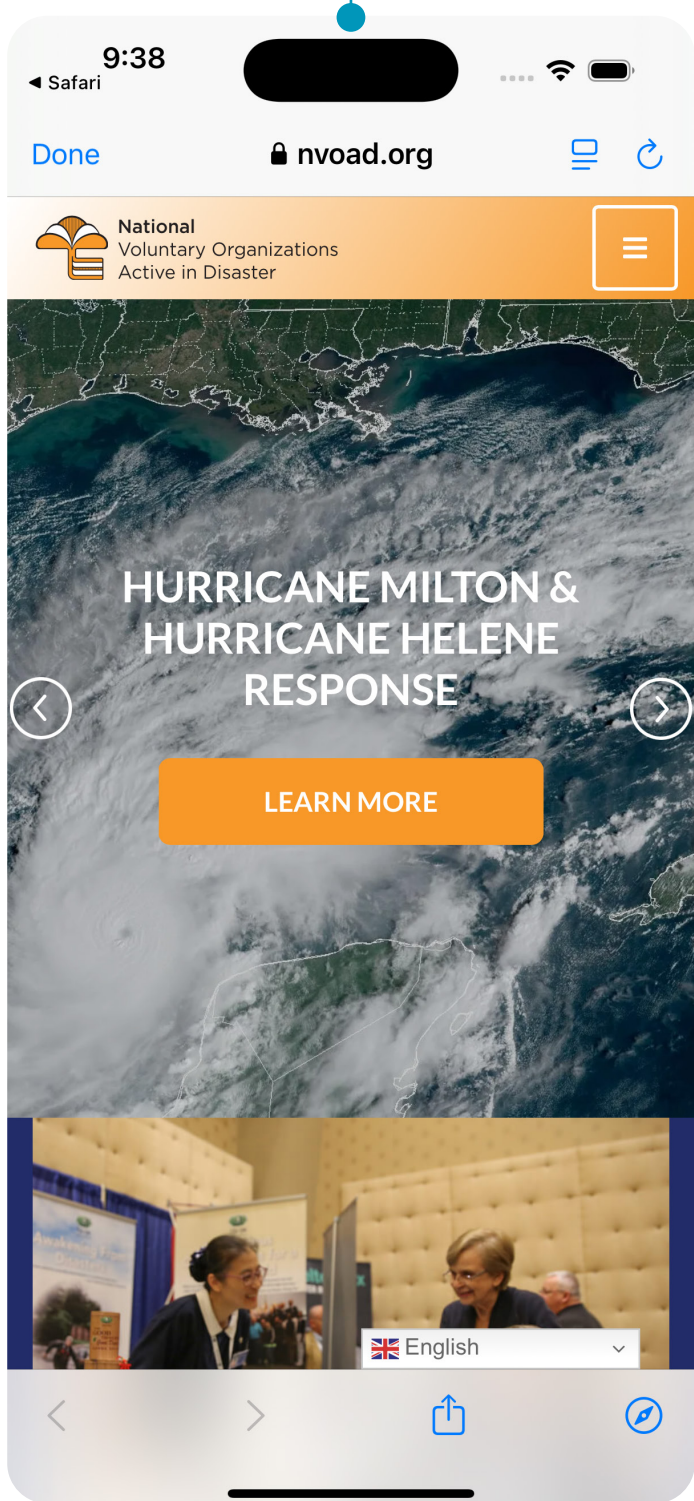
Perishable directory map
